We have received all your donated optics, 3 spotting scopes (Swarovski 20x60, Optolyth 20x60, and Hensoldt wetzlart 25x56) with 3 tripods, and a backpack in good condition on 30 June 2022. Since, we received your donations, all spotting scopes used for fieldwork and training.

It was a great donation to us and the young kids in the field to observe the birds and wildlife. We organize bird-watching events and training for the school kids from the small village and rangers of the Daurian Strictly Protected area of Mongolia tree times. At least 160 kids and 15 rangers participated in the event and trained in so far. It was good to use spotting scopes to identify the birds and teach the birds to kids in the lakes and wetlands of Dauria.
